Mamou had an apparent JaQualyon Arvie long touchdown run called back on a holding penalty, but the Green Demons moved 67 yards in nine plays capped by a 8-yard touchdown run by Jaylen Griffin with 34 seconds left in the game.

The kick was blocked and St. Edmund closed the game with a 55-18 advantage.

The Jays finished with 351 yards rushing, led by Doucet (16-165) and Brad Miller (16-114).

Miller also completed 2-of-5 passes for 74 yards.
